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Visual Arts Concentration: Courses in Art & Design and/or Film, Television & Media, in addition to the 9 credits specified in the interdisciplinary core

Computer and Information Sciences Concentration²: Courses in EECS and/or the School of Information. Students should take MATH 115 to fulfill their Math requirement

Multidisciplinary Studies Concentration: Student designs a coherent plan of study in a mix of disciplines complementary to PAT. The plan of study must be approved by the student's PAT advisor no later than the first semester of their sophomore year. Any deviations from the plan must be approved by the PAT advisor
