Performance Requirements
24 credits of major instrument to include completion of course 640 (must be elected each term)
Musperf 640: Presentation of recital during Specialist program residence
Ensemble – minimum 9 credits, including at least 4 credits elected during Specialist program residence

Additional SMTD Requirements
Minimum 12 credits of Music Education, Musicology, Music Theory, Conducting, and/or Composition
Electives selected to reflect the needs and interests of the student and to make up a coherent and defensible program of study

Minimum Total Credits Required: 30

Work elected in making up deficiencies will not count as credit toward the degree.
