Minimum Total Credits Required: At least 15 credits with a minimum of five courses chosen from each of the three categories. All eligible courses taken prior to application to the minor can be used to fulfill the 15-credit requirement. A student’s path through the minor should be developed in consultation with an advisor to meet a student’s professional goals. While taking the introductory course early in a student’s period of study is recommended, courses may be taken in any order.
