Kaźmierczak plays throughout many countries in Europe, including Lithuania, France, the Netherlands, and others. She has worked with the Hevelius Brass Quintet, and also plays a mobile carillon. She currently teaches carillon at the Music Academy in Gdańsk, and other subjects at the Elblag State Music School.
