Procedures for (Re)Applying

1. Complete application form
2. Attach a personal statement to the application form [500 words]. Explain why you feel you should be awarded a scholarship. Possible discussion points to include are: the contributions you have made to the Department of Dance, how you have progressed in your dance knowledge, skills and artistry, and creative research in the form of choreography. Please list performances you have participated in, both within the Department and in other venues. You are encouraged to provide any information that you feel will assist the Department in evaluating your application.
3. Submit all application materials to the Dance Office by **4PM, Monday, March 19, 2018**.

Applications received after 4PM, Monday, March 19, 2018 will not be considered for 2018-2019 merit-based awards.
